

## Minimum requirements for POS terminal installation

- **1.** A dry place protected from accidental contact with liquids, preventing any spillage onto or inside the POS terminal.
- 2. No high voltage devices, or devices that create a magnetic field and can affect the operation of a POS terminal, are allowed near the place of installation.
- **3.** A POS terminal must be installed at the place where payments for goods and/or services are made or cash transactions are performed.
- 4. Power supply and stable operation of the telephone line at the installation location (not more than 20% of failed data exchange attempts).
- 5. Connection of a POS terminal to the telephone/power lines requires:
  - **5.1.** installation of a distributing box no further than 1.5 metres from the estimated terminal location;
  - **5.2.** authorisation to make outgoing calls to numbers in Riga;
  - **5.3.** if your company has an internal telephone system (exchange), the installation location requires an analogue port, a ~220 V socket with grounding no further than 3 metres from the intended location of the terminal.
- 6. Connection of a POS terminal to Internet/power lines requires:
  - 6.1. constant Internet connection (both static and dynamic IP addresses are possible);
  - **6.2.** free access to such ports as 18003; 18004; 18007; 11760; 11709; 7608, and the following IP addresses: 195.160.171.96, 193.29.39.1;
  - **6.3.** Ethernet cable of sufficient length (a standard computer cable with an RJ45 connector), a ~220 V socket with grounding no further than 3 metres from the estimated terminal location.
- 7. Installation of a GPRS mobile POS terminal requires a SIM card with the following parameters:
  - 7.1. constant GPRS connection;
  - 7.2. disabled PIN input request;
  - **7.3.** good cell coverage area.
- **8.** Installation of a Wi-Fi mobile POS terminal requires a wireless Internet router with a permanent internet connection.
